### 35th Annual Nico Snel Young Artist Competition

The Nico Snel Young Artist Competition is open to any North Olympic Peninsula student instrumentalist or vocalist within the age range of 4 - 22 years old at the time of the competition, and who did not win first prize in the Senior Competition of the preceding year.

Cash awards: 1st Place \$500, 2nd Place \$250, 3rd Place \$200

### 15th Annual "Dunior" Young Artist Competition

The Nico Snel **Dunier** Young Artist Competition was designed for those students who may not be ready yet for the Symphony's Young Artist Competition. The Junior Competition is open to any North Olympic Peninsula instrumentalist (piano, strings, woodwinds, brass, percussionists, etc.), who is age 14 or under at the time of the competition, and who did not win first prize in any prior Junior or Senior Young Artist Competition.

Cash awards: 1st Place \$250, 2nd Place \$125, 3rd Place \$75

The Young Artist Competition is open to any North Olympic Peninsula instrumental music student who will be younger than 22 years old June 1, 2017 and who did not win first prize in the 2016 competition (prior years' winners are eligible to compete).

Competitors are to perform a selection of music of concert quality.

This selection need not be a concerto and your performance should not exceed 10 minutes.

Competitors are expected to announce their selections, say the full name of composer, and the year the composition was written. Competitors must provide their own piano accompanist for the competition (only piano accompaniment is permitted). Please note that there will be only one piano available.

The competition will begin at approximately 9:30 a.m., and applicants should arrive at least 10 minutes prior to their performance. You must be present to compete (video tapes or DVDs are not permitted).

Results will be e-mailed to competitors the afternoon of the competition.

Cash awards: 1st-place \$500, 2nd-place \$250, 3rd-place \$200.
