The Nico Snel Young Artist Competition is open to any North Olympic Peninsula student orchestral instrumentalist or pianist within the age range of 4 - 22 years old at the time of the competition, and who did not win first prize in the Senior Competition of the preceding year.

Cash awards: 1st Place \$500, 2nd Place \$300, 3rd Place \$200

20th Annual JUNIOP Young Artist Competition

The Nico Snel **Dunier** Young Artist Competition was designed for those students who may not be ready yet for the Symphony's Young Artist Competition. The Junior Competition is open to any North Olympic Peninsula instrumentalist (piano, strings, woodwinds, brass, percussionists, etc.), who is age 14 or under at the time of the competition, and who did not win first prize in any prior Junior or Senior Young Artist Competition.

Cash awards: 1st Place \$250, 2nd Place \$150, 3rd Place \$100

Open to orchestra instrumentalists (strings, woodwinds, brass, and percussion) and pianists, age 4-22. Competitors are to perform a selection of classical music of concert quality. This selection need not be a concerto and your performance should not exceed 10 minutes. Competitors must provide their own piano accompanist for the competition (only piano accompaniment is permitted). Please note that there will be only one piano available. **Limited spots available!**

Pre-recorded performances will not be accepted for the competition. Results will be announced after the competition.
